### Day1 Arrive Tokyo Narita (NRT)

Upon arrive Tokyo Narita, please take the Shuttle bus to hotel by self. Hotel check in after 15:00pm. Rest of the day will be at your own leisure to enjoy. Meals arrangement on own.

### Day2 Tokyo-Mt.Fuji (B/L/D)

After breakfast, Then overlooking the beautiful [Tokyo sky tree]-634 meters high. We Proceed to [Sensoji Temple] - known as Asakusa Temple, is Tokyo's oldest and most popular temple. Guests can purchase souvenir in the front Street of the Temple. we will visit the famous Tokyo landmark-[Imperial Palace Double Bridge]. Because of the reflection reflected in the water like a pair of glasses, it is also known as the glasses bridge. And then travel to [Ginza Area]\*; go to [LAOX Duty Free Shop] Ginza store for crazy shopping. Back to the hotel, you can enjoy the hotel spa facilities in the evening. Enjoy king crab dinner tonight.

### Day3 Mt. Fuji - Hakone (B/L/D)

Drive to the [Lake Kawaguchi] is located in the border Fuji kawaguchiko and Minobu, southern Yamanashi Prefecture near Mount Fuji, Japan. It is the second largest of the Fuji Five Lakes in terms of surface area. Then go to the Mt Fuji hillside [Mt Fuji five order] (depends on weather) enjoy the beauty of Mt Fuji in the most beautiful view. [Oshino Hakkai] is the melting water of Mount Fuji after 80 years of filtration, has become now the 8 gush of spring water, due to patchwork scattered with eight springs, "Oshino Hakkai" hence the name and famous Quartet. Proceed to [Peace Park]. Peace Park is set up to express the Japanese accusations of war, pray for the desire of world peace, meaningful and quiet and elegant. Enjoy hot spring bath in the hotel at night.

### Day4 Hakone - Nagoya (B/L)

Drive to [Tsumago Juku], was the forty-third of the sixty-nine stations of the Nakasendo, an ancient road that connected Kyoto and Edo during the Edo period. It was also the last of eleven stations along the Kisoji, which was the precursor to a part of the Nakasendo, running through the Kiso Valley. Then go to Nagoya's famous shrine - [Atsuta Shrine]\*, located in Atsuta-ku, Nagoya, Aichi Prefecture in Japan. The shrine is familiarly known as Atsuta-Sama (Venerable Atsuta) or simply as Miya (the Shrine). Since ancient times, it has been especially revered; ranking with the Great Shrine of Ise. The 200,000 m<sup>2</sup> shrine complex draws over 6 million 500 thousand visitors annually. Then visit [Jewelry Shop].

Hotel: Lake Biwa Otsu Prince Hotel or similar

### Day5 Nagoya -Kyoto-Osaka (B/L)

After breakfast, we will visit [Kinkaku-ji]\*, officially named Rokuon-ji, the pavilion functions as a sharden, housing relics of the Buddha (Buddha's Ashes). The top two stories of the pavilion are covered with pure gold leaf. Then proceed to [Todai-ji Temple]\*, is a Buddhist temple complex, that was once one of the powerful Seven Great Temples, located in the city of Nara, Japan. [Nara Park]\* is a public park located in the city of Nara, Japan; the park is under the control of Nara Prefecture. The park is one of the "Places of Scenic Beauty" designated by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT).

Hotel: Imperial Hotel Osaka or Kanku Nikko Hotel or Similar

### Day6 Depart Osaka Kansai (B)

After breakfast, please take shuttle bus (at your own expense) to Osaka Kansai airport by self, and then take flight back to your sweet home (Our guide will advise how to take shuttle bus on Day 5).
