# Maritime Provinces and Whale Watching

Highlights: Fredericton, Saint John, Bay of Fundy, Moncton, Charlottetown, Peggy's Cove, Halifax, Whale Watching, Quebec City Duration: 7 days, 6 nights

### Day 1: Ottawa - Grand Falls - Fredericton

We depart Ottawa at 6:00 AM im the morning and drive to Fredericton. We will stop by Grand Falls on the Saint John River, and go through the Hartland Covered Bridge, the longest covered bridge in the world. After lunch, we will drive to the capital of New Brunswick: Fredericton. Nestled alongside the Saint John River, Fredericton boasts tree-lined avenues graced with Victorian architecture, complementing a vibrant cultural life, fine galleries and museums, lively outdoor caf &, and miles of riverfront trails. We will overnight at Ramada Hotel Fredericton.

### Day 2: Fredericton - Saint John - Monton

Today, we discover the authentic Acadian culture and natural riches of New Brunswick by touring the east coast on a scenic drive. We will drive to Saint John, a city on the Bay of Fundy, in New Brunswick. It's known for the Reversing Rapids, a phenomenon caused by bay tides colliding with the Saint John River. Then we make our way to Bouctouche Bay, home to one of the few remaining great sand dunes on the northeastern coast of North America. We can swim along the long stretches of warm water beaches in the Atlantic. After a comfortable lunch, we drive to the famous Hopewell Rocks in the upper reaches of the Bay of Fundy. We witness the world's highest tides and the illustrious "Flower Pot Rocks" fantastically rising above the bay floor. After being part of this natural phenomenon, we head to Moncton to uncover the secret of the Magnetic Hill. We will overnight at Quality Inn Moncton.

# Day 3: Moncton - Peggy's Cover - Halifax

We begin the day with a three-hour drive to Peggy's Cove, a small rural community located in St. Margaret's Bay. On the rocky coastal landscape of Nova Scotia, we find the postcard-perfect village of

Peggy's Cove and the most photographed lighthouse in the world. We have lunch and then make our way to the Nova Scotian capital of Halifax. As the most populous city in the Maritimes, Halifax is steeped in history, rich in culture, and refreshingly cosmopolitan. It bustles and thrives with all the energy and amenities of a capital city but within minutes of the city's core, Halifax offers the small coastal villages, country charm, and wilderness for which Nova Scotia is known. With over 400 kilometers of dramatic coastline, white sand beaches, and one of the world's largest natural harbors, it is clear that life here revolves around the sea. Some sites of interest we visit include the fortress on Citadel Hill, the Seaport, and the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic. In the evening, stroll along the city's cobblestone walkways while taking advantage of the city's fine dining, great music, fashionable boutiques, and whimsical craft shops. We will overnight at Future Inn Halifax.

### Day 4: Halifx - Charlottetown

Today we continue our journey by crossing the Confederation Bridge from New Brunswick to Prince Edward Island, arriving in Charlottetown. Known as the Gentle Island, P.E.I. is Canada's smallest and greenest province. Cradled on the waves of the Gulf of St. Lawrence, the island is known for the vivid colors of its gently rolling landscape. We have lunch in its charming small-town capital and then visit Cavendish Beach and the house of Green Gables, where we see how author Lucy Maud Montgomery found the romantic inspiration for her early twentieth-century coming-of-age classic. # $\label{eq:continuous} \textbf{Day 5: Charlottetown} - \textbf{Campbellton - Rimouski}$

Today we will continue our journey by crossing the Confederation to salmon's hometown: Campbellton, where you can take a photo with the world's biggest salmon fish. After lunch we depart for Reford Gardens, we will tread from one discovery to the next, enraptured by the beauty of landscaping where we will find more than 2000 species and varieties, both indigenous and exotic, perennials, annuals, and shrubs. We will overnight at Hotel hiversel Rievere-Du-Loup.

### Day 6: Rimouski – Whale Watching - Quebec City

We begin the day with a large ferry across the endless St. Lawrence River from the harbor in Riviere-Du-Loup, Quebec, to whale watching in the Gulf of St. Lawrence. We embark on a three-hour whale-watching cruise to discover the diverse collection of marine life that thrives in this unique maritime estuary. Experienced on-board guides help us identify the many different species of whales that come to feed here, including Humpback, Finback, Minke, and Beluga Whales. After the cruise, we head back east to Quebec City and check in at Hotel Ch âteau Repotel.

### Day 7: Quebec City - Ottawa

On our last day of the trip, we set off for a tour of Quebec City, the first ancient city in Canadian history. In this charming city, historical sites can be seen everywhere. We will spend the day sightseeing and shopping in the old Quebec city, exploring historical treasures like Battlefields Park, the Quebec Parliament, Chateau Frontenac, Place d'Armes, and the Citadel. After lunch, we will leave Quebec City for home. We arrive home at around 8:00 PM after an unforgettable week on Canada's East Coast.

# 加東三省七日遊

漫步廊桥,潮汐花瓶岩,龙虾之都,安妮小屋,红沙滩,王子岛, 天涯海角,磁力山揭秘,天涯海角,哈里法斯,三文鱼故乡,天堂花园, 出海观鲸,魁北克城

# 1. 渥太華-佛萊德利克頓

清晨從渥太華出發前往海洋三省之一新不倫 瑞克省首府佛萊德利克頓, 途徑怪石為底的 瀑布小鎮並可漫步於世界最長廊橋哈特蘭廊 橋,據當地傳說,屏住呼吸穿過廊橋便能美 夢得償。當晚入住 Fredericton酒店。

# 2. 佛萊德利克頓 - 聖約翰 - 蒙克頓

早餐後啟程前往海灣城市聖約翰市, 該市為 新不倫瑞克省最大的城市, 主要由愛爾蘭裔 移民組成, 市內沿海而建的維多利亞式的建 築多是英國殖民最早登陸加國後逐漸留下。 聖約翰附近的倒流瀑布、磁力山和大龍蝦雕 像卻是非常著名的景觀。聖約翰河因為漲潮 時大量的海水倒灌使得入海口水勢高於河裡 的水勢, 形成了奇特的倒流瀑布 (Reversing Falls). 欣賞過聖約翰市的海水倒灌後我們 將前往新不倫瑞克省蒙克頓, 沿途暢遊保持 最大潮汐落差記錄的海中花瓶巖石海灘。我 們將目睹潮汐的快速劇烈變化, 並漫步於本 為海底的花瓶巖石海灘之上, 在造物奇跡般 的高大花瓶巖中穿行。午飯後遊覽神秘的重 力紊亂的磁力山, 並遊覽世界龍蝦之都, 一 睹栩栩如生的加東標誌性地標龍蝦雕塑. 並 在寄居蟹海灘暢遊大海。傍晚住宿於蒙克 頓。

# 3. 蒙克頓 - 天涯海角 - 哈利法克斯

從蒙克頓啟程去往加東海洋三省之一新斯科舍省海港城市哈利法克斯近郊著名的天涯海角(Peggy's Cove)參觀。那裡波瀾壯闊,驚天動地的海浪和造型奇特的花崗大巖石、古老美麗的燈塔令人陶醉。然後前往著名的哈裏法斯市。首先參觀哈裏法斯古老軍事城堡 Citadel,隨後乘坐海陸兩用觀光車遊覽:哈裏法克斯古老市中心和大西洋艦隊軍港,飽覽海灣景色,聽當地專業熱情的導遊在海上在陸地上介紹軍事古城的歷史和故事。隨後於夕陽黃昏下,在海港享受當地美食。夜晚下榻哈裏法斯市區酒店。

# 4. 哈裹法斯-王子島

早餐後前往加拿大迷你省份美麗的愛德華王子島首府一夏洛特城,參觀加拿大聯邦誕生地一王子島省議會大樓,參觀像燃燒在碧藍海水中火焰一般的紅沙灘和歷史悠久王子島代表性景點的安妮小木屋,當日之壓軸好戲為在酒店餐廳品嘗豐盛鮮美的龍蝦晚宴。傍晚住宿於蒙克頓。

# 5. 王子島 - 天堂花園 - 狼河鎮

早餐後跨越加拿大第一大橋聯邦大橋途徑東海岸參觀三文魚故鄉一崁柏頓,與世界最大三文魚雕像合影留念。隨後前往遊覽加拿大東部最著名天堂花園(Reford Gardens),超越百年歷史數千種奇花異草並且擁有來自世界各地參加花園節的花園設計師所締造的花園建築藝術展覽令人流連忘返。夜晚下榻狼河鎮酒店。

### 6. 狼河鎮 - 聖勞倫斯灣觀鯨 - 魁北克城

在魁北克省狼河鎮(Rivière-du-Loup)的海港搭乘大型渡輪橫跨一望無際的聖勞倫斯河,前往聖勞倫斯灣觀鯨。您有機會觀賞到大大小小的鯨魚在海中追逐嬉戲:重達130噸的大藍鯨、50噸的直尾鯨和8噸左右的大貂鯨。您還可以欣賞美麗的聖勞倫斯海灣風光:海中小島、觀賞海獅、海豹、海豚、各種海島等。夜晚下榻魁北克城酒店。

## 7. 魁北克城 - 渥太華

早餐後出發遊覽加拿大歷史上第一古城魁北克城,盡情擁抱歷史,在這充滿濃郁歐陸色彩的魁北克古城,歷史遺跡處處可見。北美唯一保存最完整的古城墙,雍容華貴的古堡大酒店,清秀脫俗的老教堂,氣勢宏偉的魁北克省議會大廈,備受遊客歡迎的仿古馬車及街邊藝術家等都令您忍不住拍照留念。午餐後起程返回渥太華,約晚上八時抵達渥太華。
